The Religious Coalition is the largest provider of Emergency Financial Assistance in Frederick County outside of the local government. It manages the largest and only year round emergency shelter, the Alan P. Linton, Jr. Emergency Shelter, in Frederick County.

The Religious Coalition's programs and services keep people in their homes and prevent homelessness

The Religious Coalition provides *support for clients facing eviction, foreclosure or termination of utility services.*

The Religious Coalition provides medical services, prescription medications and emergency dental services

The Religious Coalition manages the eight Food Banks in Frederick County.

The Religious Coalition provides personal hygiene supplies to clients on an emergency basis.

The Coalition operates 3 programs in the Alan P. Linton, Jr. Emergency Shelter:

The Cold Weather Shelter

(provides warm, safe shelter during the Winter to homeless individuals)

The Day Shelter

(provides respite from the cold weather to physically and mentally handicapped clients along with the frail elderly)

Exodus Project

(operates from Spring to Fall; a 90 day program moving homeless clients into jobs and housing with a 75% success rate)

The Religious Coalition is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and all contributions are tax deductible to the fullest extent allowed by law.
